Chorus digitalis is the first choir in the world composed of synthetic voices controlled in real time by graphic tablet. The synthetic voice instrument is called **Cantor Digitalis**. Resulting from research on the gestural control of voice synthesis initiated in 2005 by [Christophe d'Alessandro](#), Chorus digitalis has publically performed for the first time in March 2011 in Vancouver with its designers, Sylvain Le Beux, [Boris Doval](#), [Lionel Feugère](#) and [Christophe d'Alessandro](#). The current project is led by [Lionel Feugère](#) and [Olivier Perrotin](#).
